

### **CALL FOR EXECUTIVE BOARD NOMINATIONS**

There are four seats on the USCF Executive Board up for election in 2005. These are four-year terms that will begin at the conclusion of the Delegates Meeting in August of 2005.

Any USCF member can be nominated for election to the Executive Board of the USCF. Each nomination must be accompanied by a petition containing the signatures of 30 or more Voting Members of the U.S. Chess Federation, and by a filing fee of \$250 payable to the U.S. Chess Federation.

Both the petition and the filing fee must be received by either the USCF Secretary or the USCF office by January 10, 2005. A Voting Member of the USCF for the purposes of the coming election is defined as: Any USCF member residing in the USA who will be at least 16 years of age as of June 1, 2005.
