If you are with a group, it's recommended that each participant fill out a medical form listing their parents, coach, or another adult who can allow medical treatment if necessary. All participants should have contact information on them in case of an emergency. Those who are with a group should have contact information for both their parents and the person appointed as chaperone.

BEFORE THE TOURNAMENT:

Tour the property.

After your arrival it's a good idea to tour the property so everyone becomes familiar with the property's layout. Look for your main playing hall, Skittles area, and Chess Control.
