

Celebrate Passover with Congregation Kol Ami

Dear US Chess visitors,

Congregation Kol Ami (CKA) is ready and happy to help you celebrate Passover while you are in the North Dallas area. We are delighted to fulfill the mitzvah of hachnasat orchim.

If you wish to join a family Seder the first night of Passover, we will arrange to have you join a CKA family. Please be aware CKA is a Reform congregation, so there will be limited availability for a strictly Kosher Seder. We have a few homes that maintain a Kosher household, so if that is a must, we will place you with those families. If you are not so concerned with Kashrut, the sky's the limit.

On the second night of Passover, CKA hosts a potluck community Seder. YOU ARE NOT REQUIRED TO BRING ANYTHING. Know the community meal will exclude any pork or shellfish. It will be a meat meal, but we do allow non-Kosher meat and produce to be used in the dishes.
