## BEFORE WE BEGIN...

- Please note, this is a general presentation.
- It's not designed to cover all possible use cases.
- If you run into any problems, please feel free to contact US Chess, and we'll help you get through them.


## TEAM LEVELS (NEW AS OF JANUARY 2020)

- US Chess now offers team registration packages for Standard Teams, Premium Teams, and Deluxe Teams.
- Standard Teams are schools that register players to compete as teams, but do not need team rooms. This is free to all schools, and requires no special registration.
- Premium Teams are schools OR groups that register players to compete, and reserve team rooms between $\$ 400$ and $\$ 999$ in cost. Rook Teams must complete the team room registration process, and will be assigned a team room as part of their registration..
- Deluxe Teams are schools OR groups that register players to compete, and reserve team rooms at least $\$ 1,000$ in cost. King Teams will receive the benefits of Rook Teams, and will also have their team name and logo (if applicable) prominently displayed in a slide show in front of the main playing hall throughout the tournament.
- US Chess will advise Premium Teams and Deluxe Teams of their status as part of their team room assignment notification. King Teams will also be asked to submit their team name and logo at this time.


## HOW TO ACCESS THE RESERVATION SYSTEM



- This is from the webpage for SuperNationals VI. The reservation system link will always be presented like this for every national event.
- ALWAYS go to the tournament page to access the team room reservation link.
- The link that says, "Click Here to Reserve a Team Room", is where the reservation system is located. This link can change without notice, though, so we recommend going through the tournament webpage.


## HOW TO ACCESS THE RESERVATION SYSTEM

- This is a long, singlepage form. We'll break it into smaller pieces for you. Don't worry we'll present them in order.


## HOW TO PROVIDE CONTACT INFORMATION



- This is where you provide your organization's contact information.
- Please fill out as many fields as possible.
- At a minimum, we need a name, valid email address, and valid phone number.

- This is the second part of the contact form.
- The top image is what you'll see if your onsite contact is the same as the organizational contact.
- The bottom image is what you'll see if your on-site contact is different.


## HOW TO SELECT ROOMS



- This is the top of the room request menu.
- It's designed to allow you to rank the rooms you're willing to rent in descending order of preference.
- You must fill in both fields. The number of team rooms tells us how much the deposit will be. The number of players helps us get you a room that fits your needs.


## HOW TO SELECT ROOMS



- It is CRITICAL that you give your best-faith estimate of how many players you expect to bring.
- First preference will be given to groups of $15+$ players.
- If your group's registrations as of the early-entry deadline do not equal or exceed 15 players, you may not be able to secure a room.
- Once all groups of $15+$ players have space guarantees, groups with fewer than 15 players will be considered.
- All team registrations will be verified at the early entry deadline - please encourage your players to sign up by the first early entry date to ensure an accurate accounting of your team size.


## HOW TO SELECT ROOMS



- You will use this area to tell us your room preferences.
- First, though, you need to know which rooms are being rented, and their details.
- Note the "Click here" link at the top of this area. What happens when you click it?


## HOW TO SELECT ROOMS



- If you use that "Click here" link, you will get a list of team rooms available for rent. This list will appear in a new browser tab or window.
- Each room has its name, area (in square feet), max occupancy and price listed. They're listed in alphabetical order.
- You may use the dropdown menu at the top of the form to control how many lines appear on one page.


## HOW TO SELECT ROOMS

- This page is still open while you look at the team room

- The special instructions box is a place to tell us additional things you may need.
- Please note that any nonstandard setup or extra items (chocolate fountain, etc.) may require special arrangement and charges with the convention center.


## HOW TO SELECT ROOMS

- At some events, we may offer spaces in the skittles area for groups to use as team rooms.
- These will be roped-off areas with tables and chairs, reserved for your group. They will cost less than traditional team rooms.
- These rooms will be clearly labeled on the team room list ("Skittles Area A", etc.)
- If you prefer to be assigned a space in the skittles area, simply list it at the top of your preferences.
- If you do not want to be assigned a space in the skittles area, please type a note to that effect in the "Special Instructions, Needs or Comments" text box.

－Almost done！Now we just have to get the deposit payment information．
－Remember，each room you want requires a \＄125 deposit，which becomes non－refundable once you are guaranteed space by US Chess．
－Once your card information is entered， click＂Submit＂once．

## HOW TO SUBMIT A RESERVATION REQUEST



- Once your payment has cleared our processor, you'll see a confirmation page like this.
- Your organizational contact will also get a complete summary by email of the form you've submitted. This should arrive very shortly after the form is submitted.


## WHAT TO EXPECT AFTER A RESERVATION REQUEST IS SUBMITTED

- The reservation system will be open for a period of one week.
- At the end of the week, the submitted reservation requests will be analyzed to determine which groups will be assigned team rooms.
- Notification will be sent to each group as to whether they will receive a team room.
- Groups who are not given a guarantee of room assignment will have their deposits refunded.
- Specific room assignments will not be announced until the week of the tournament.
- Payment for the balance of a room (cost, less the deposit) is to be remitted to Chess Control at the tournament no later than COB Friday.


## WHAT TO EXPECT AFTER A RESERVATION REQUEST IS SUBMITTED

- US Chess will analyze a number of factors when considering team room assignments.
- The factors considered will be estimated attendance, capacity of available rooms and number of verified registrations for each group as of the early-entry deadline.
- To evaluate space needs, US Chess will use a formula that is applied to your estimated number of players.
- The formula will be: (\# of players) x (multiplier) = estimated capacity
- The multiplier will vary, depending on the event under consideration.
- National High School (K-12) Championship: 2.0
- National Junior High School (K-9) Championship: 2.25
- National Elementary (K-6) Championship: 2.75
- National K-12 Grades Championship: 2.5
- SuperNationals: 2.5


## "WE DIDN’T GET A R00M! WHAT CAN WE D0?"

- Team rooms are a popular feature of our national events.
- While we want every group that requests a team room to get one, sometimes we will have more requests than rooms to give.
- Any unsuccessful requests go on a waiting list, in the order they are received. If there are subsequent cancellations, we work through the waiting list.
- We do not "hide" or "stash" extra, unadvertised team rooms. When we put out a list of team rooms, we show every available room.
- We have created a free message board for groups that might want to share team rooms. It is at http://uscteamrooms.boards.net. You will need to create a login and password to use it.


## FINAL TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- Review the list of available team rooms
- Review the map of the convention center
- Carefully plan your order quantity and preference for rooms
- List multiple rooms in order of preference - the more options we have to assign you a room, the more likely you will receive one of your choosing
- Make your reservation request within the one-week registration window
- Make sure you have at least the number of players you estimated to bring, registered before the early-entry deadline
- Watch for the email detailing which rooms you have been assigned (within one week of the event)
- Be prepared to remit payment of the balance at the tournament
- Get ready to come have a great time!
